Membership in Harmony Central Chorus is open to female singers ages 16 and up. We recommend anyone interested in joining to first attend at least three rehearsals as a visitor, to get familiar with the barbershop style of singing and which vocal range feels most comfortable. The four parts in barbershop harmony consist of:

Tenor (the highest harmony part)

Lead (usually sings the melody)

*Baritone (harmonizes above and below
the melody line)*

Bass (the lowest harmony part)
